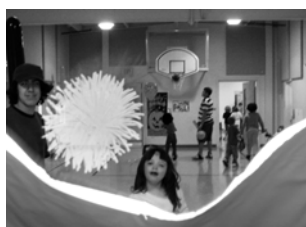
We thank **YOU** for sending us your "empty jars" and we praise God for filling them for the benefit of His children!
